What is NB-IRDT?

- Research data centre and data custodian as defined in privacy legislation, hosting anonymized but linkable government program data
- Makes prepared linked data files available to researchers in a secure environment
- Researcher- or custodian-provided data (e.g., clinical trials data) can be linked to administrative data
- The data platform for the CIHR SPOR SUPPORT Unit in NB

Data holdings

Current datasets from GNB/DH

- Citizen database (medicare registry)
- Discharge abstracts database, physician billing data
- Vital statistics, trauma database, chronic disease indicators
- Cancer registry, cancer screening registries
- Medicare provider registry

In development – DH/Regional Health Authorities

NB drug plan, mental health, lab and clinical data

In preparation - other provincial departments

- Provincial Nominee landing records (GNB/PETL)
- Long term care (GNB/SD)
- Workers comp claims data (Worksafe NB)

• In development – IRCC

Using the data - work underway

- Stage at diagnosis and breast cancer screening
- Spatial and seasonal patterns in mental health hospitalizations among youth
- The effect of surgical experience on patient outcomes
- Evaluating the impact of hospital rationalization
- Small area rate variation and forecasting future population
- Indicators of community wellness and intergenerational poverty in North End Saint John [LivingSJ]
- The costs of occupation-related cancers [Morneau-Sheppell]

An Act Respecting Research

Introduced March 28, 2017
Proclaimed into law May 18, 2017

The NB-IRDT/GNB Partnership

- Commitment to disclose almost all research relevant person-level data in a linkable form with NB-IRDT
 - Early years assessment, education outcomes
 - Postsecondary educational enrollment, completions
 - Labour market program participation
 - Social assistance receipt
 - Other forms of income support
 - Justice and public safety
 - Environmental, road accidents

- Firm level data
- Federal program data (ESDC, IRCC)
- Linkable Statcan data
